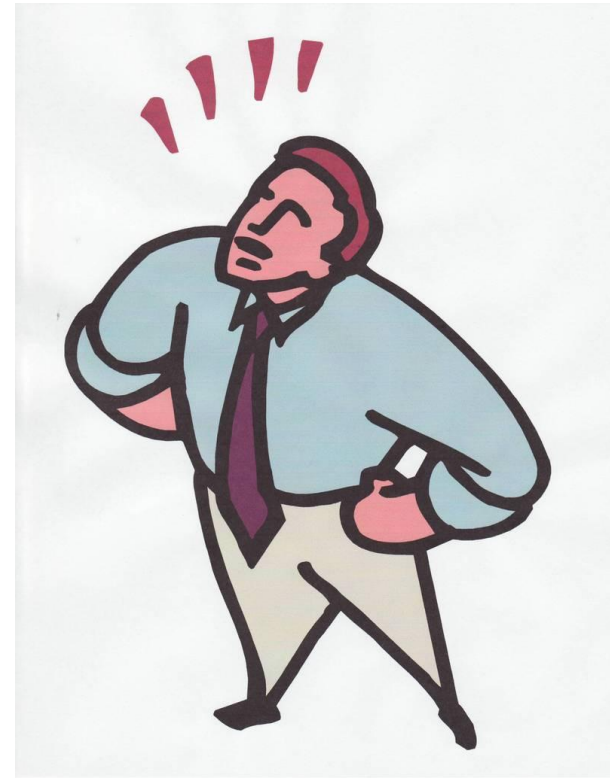


grumbling: If you are grumbling, you are complaining or letting others know you are unhappy about something.



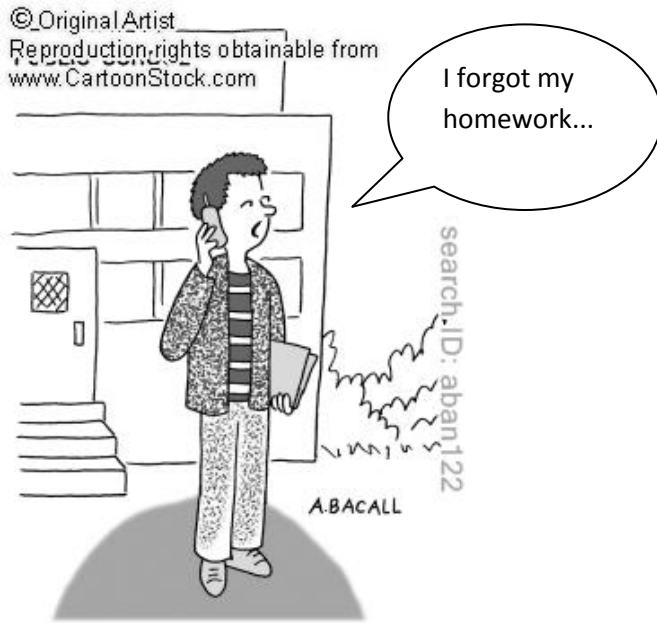
My mom was tired of my grumbling about going to my piano lesson.

bitterly: A place that is bitterly cold, is very, very cold.



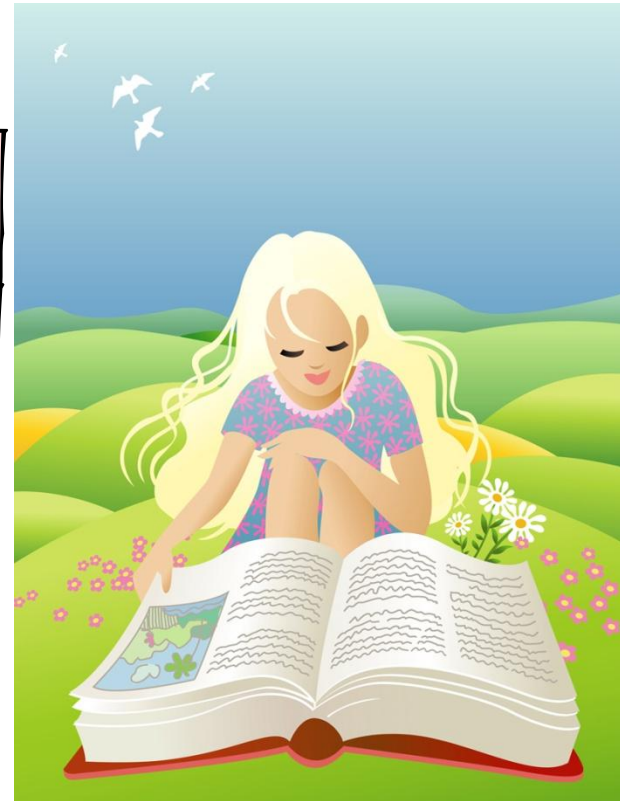
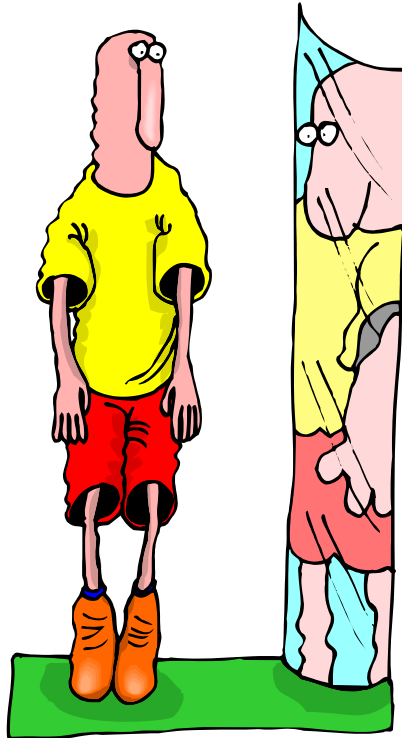
The athlete was bitterly disappointed when his team lost the match.
