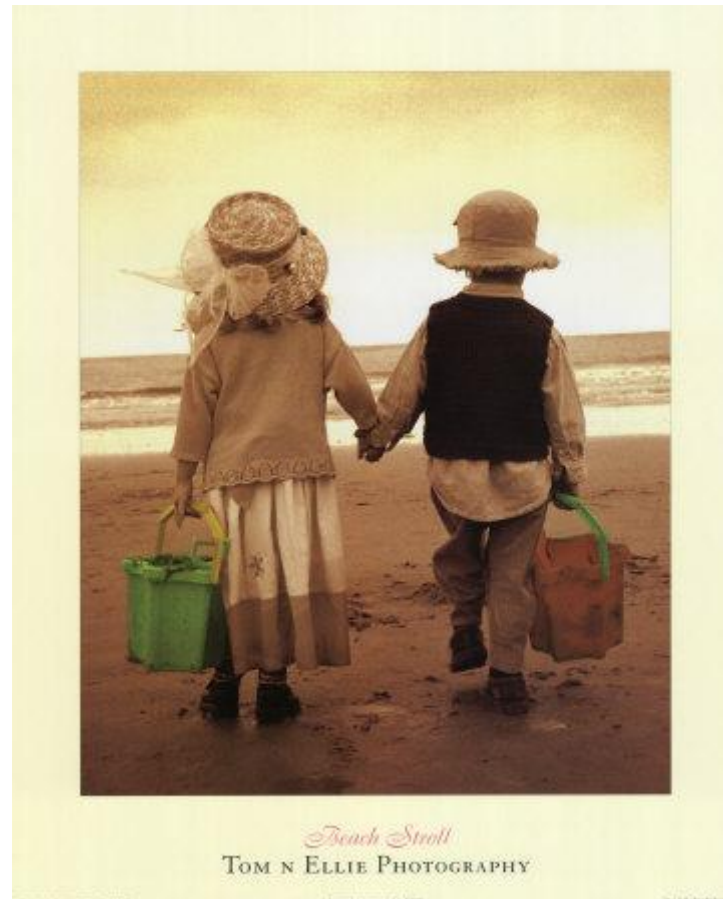
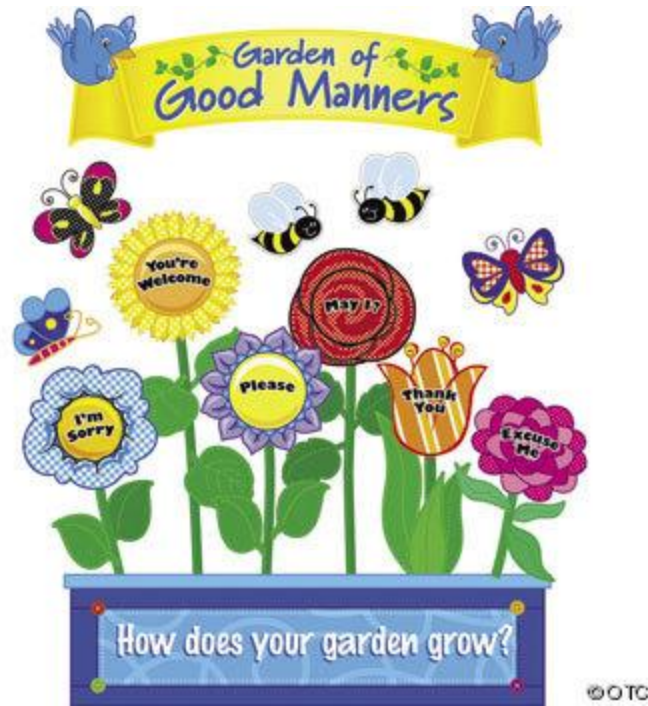


ambled: If you ambled, you walked in a slow and relaxed manner.
