locate: If you try to locate something, you try to find it.



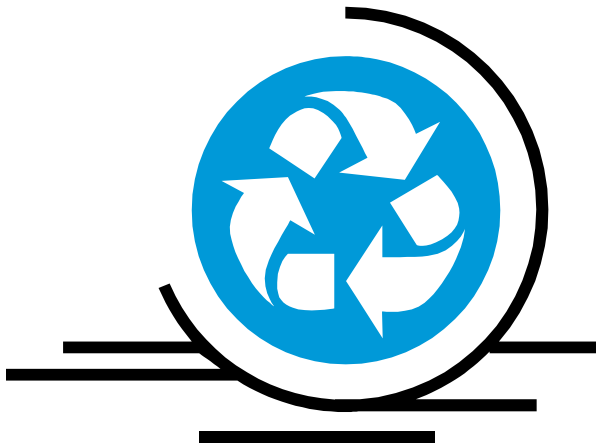
Sometimes it can be difficult to locate things on the map.
