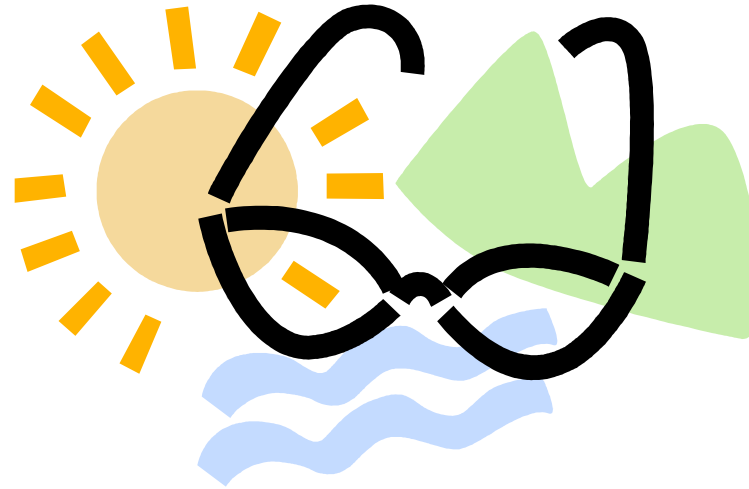
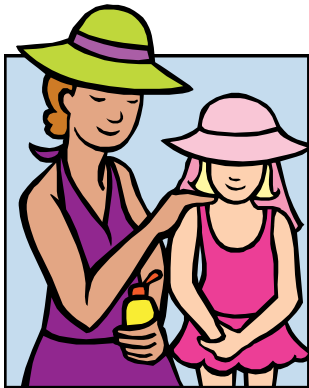


coincidence: When two similar things happen at the same time.



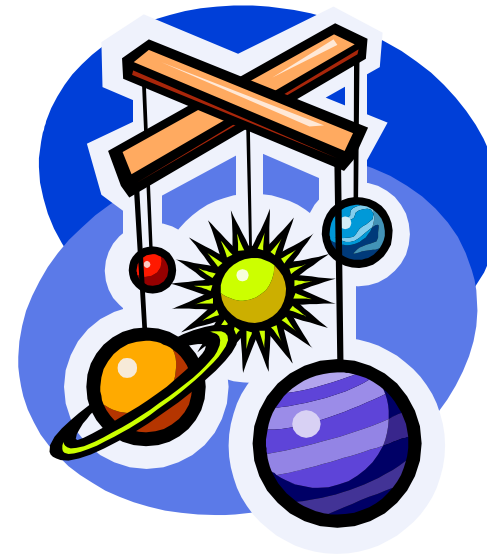
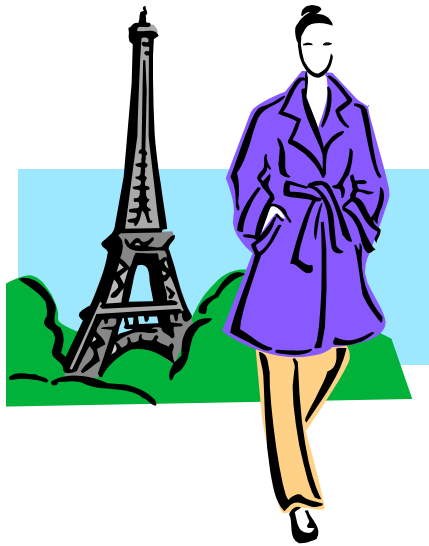
What a coincidence that my twin and I both ordered French fries.
