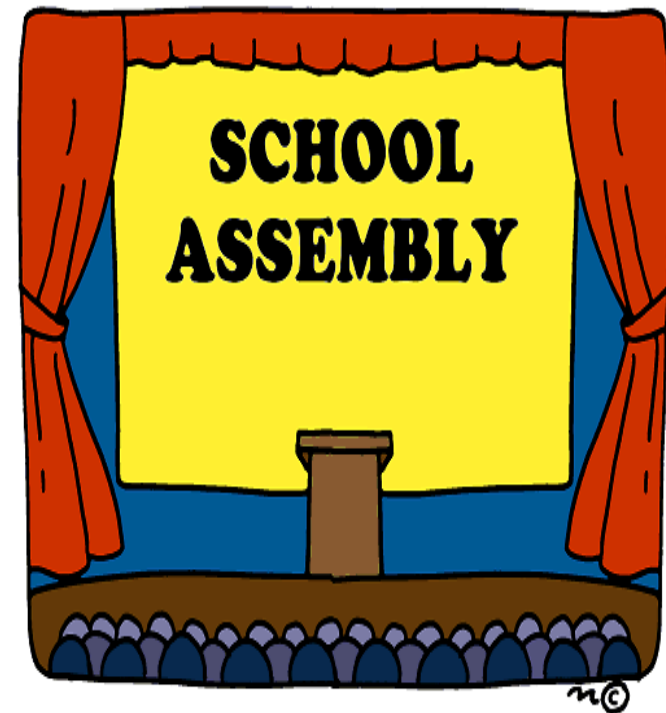


assembly: A group of people who have gathered together for a reason.

squirmed: When you move around in your seat a lot.



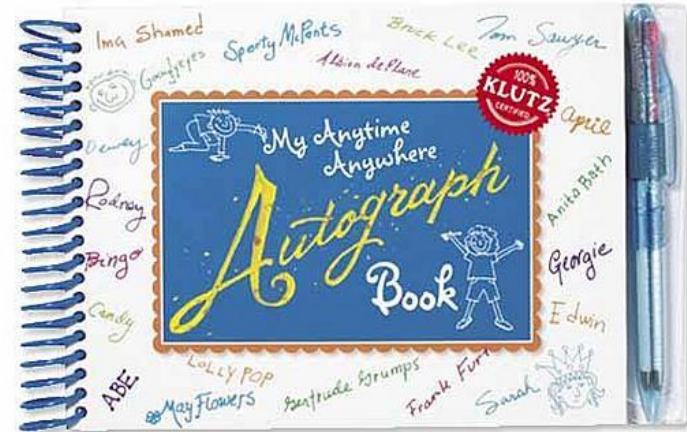
Fran squirmed in her seat waiting for her chance to get called on.

Miss Mills shared her patchwork quilt with her students.

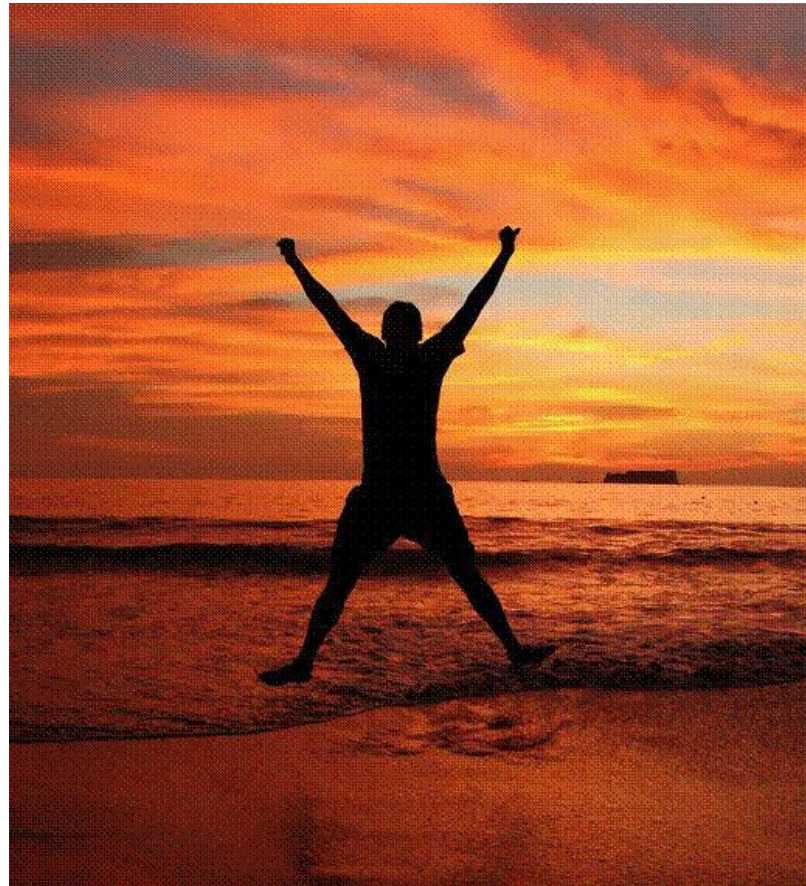
autographed: To sign or put your name on something.

Carolos was able to conquer his fear of water.

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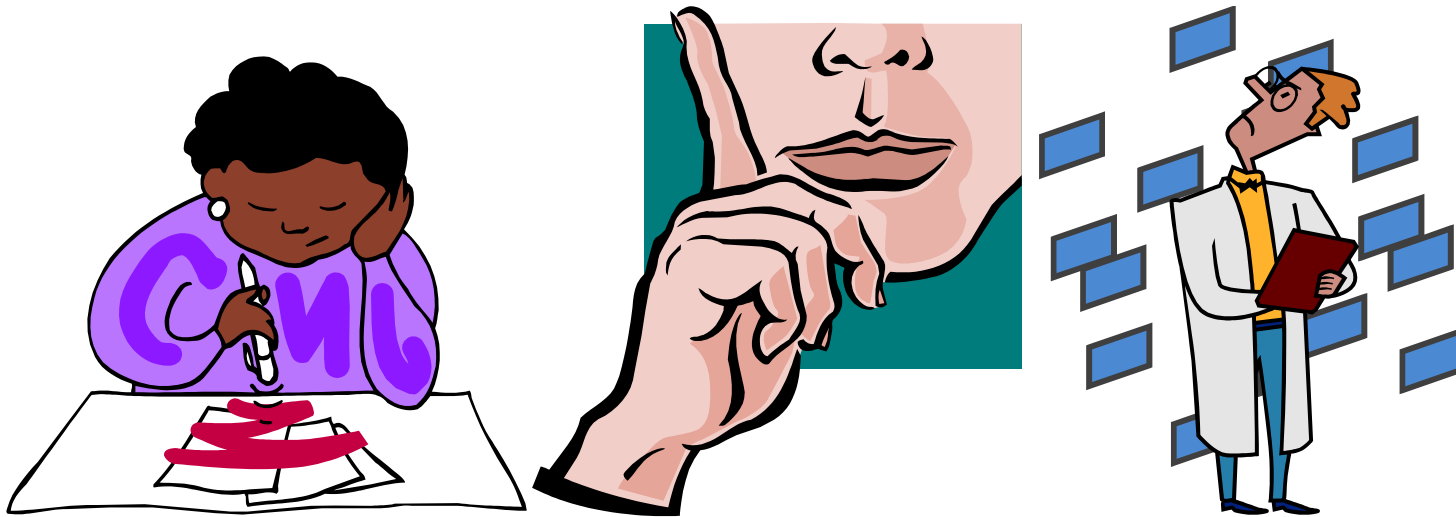
3rd L2
