popular: means that many people like something



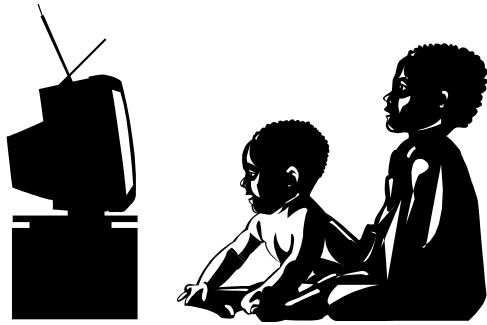
Soccer is a popular sport all around the world.
