
charging: describes the way an animal rushes toward something or someone





The animals were charging at the tour bus.


## ferocious: extremely fierce

signal: A signal is a sound or action that sends a message.

communicate: When two people or animals communicate, they tell each other things.






It is important to <u>communicate</u> with others so they know how you feel.
