reaction: the response to something or acting a certain way because of something



The <u>reaction</u> of the dog was to sit when given the command.

dense: when something is thick or tightly packed together



The <u>dense</u> forest was covered with pine trees.

generous: People who are generous are happy to share and give to others.




I have never seen such a generous amount of ice cream!

banquet: If you are going to a banquet, you are going to a fancy feast.



I can't wait to attend the <u>banquet</u> held at the Governor's Mansion.

gaze: Your gaze is a long look at something.



The <u>gaze</u> of the man was toward the city skyline.

agreeable: Something is agreeable when it is pleasing to the senses.





The music was <u>agreeable</u> to the audience that was listening.

curiosity: A curiosity is something odd and unusual that people might want to see.



Two-headed animals are a <u>curiosity</u> to people.

famine: During a famine, there is little or no food to eat.



The fields were so dry that the town was concerned about the possibility of a <u>famine</u>.

ingredients: foods that go into making a dish or recipe



The <u>ingredients</u> for making a cake are very different than the ones needed for a soup recipe.

momentum: the speed or force of something that is moving





The momentum of the roller coaster was extremely fast!
